Selected Highlights

The following statements reflect a sample of some of the important information contained in the Student Experience Inventory results. There is more to be gleaned from a careful review of the survey results. Additional custom filtered reports can be provided upon request.

Demographic Highlights

- > 100% of the respondents indicated that they are enrolled in an Undergraduate program.
- ▶ 60% indicated that they have a clear professional goal in mind for their seminary education.
- ➤ 100% indicated that they have strong off-campus support for their education.
- ➤ 11% indicated that they were first year students. 44% indicated that they were second year students, and 11% indicated third year.
- > 33% indicated that they were full time students, with 67% indicating part time.
- > 70% of the respondents were male, 30% female.
- ➤ 20% indicated that they were under 25 years of age. 10% indicated that they were over 50 years of age. 20% of the respondents indicated that they were between 40 -50 and 30% between 30-35 years of age.
- ➤ 80% identified their ethnicity as Caucasian and 20% Hispanic.
- > 70% indicated that they were married.
- > 10% indicated that they work less than 20 hours a week.
- ➤ 10% indicated that they engage in 10-20 hours of ministry per week, and 40% indicated less than 10 hours a week in ministry.
